before camp

let's do this together

Before you even come to camp, let's work together to minimize the risk at camp with a 10-day practice of good social distancing before your camp session.



enhanced staff training with COVID-19 specific content

- Each camp will have a health and safety coordinator responsible for ensuring compliance of staff and campers regarding health and safety standards.



heightened health screening before entry into camp

- Complete the 10 day **Health Screening Form** (emailed to you prior to your camp session) and bring to Opening Day.



openings & closings

what to expect for overnight & day camps

- Day and Discover Camp parents will stay in cars for the entire drop off and pick up process.
- Overnight parents will stay in their car for opening day. Closing day will be on-site, and we ask parents to mask up to limit exposure to other families, along with our coaches and staff, who will be serving campers for the rest of the summer.
- Health screening, including temperature checks of camper upon arrival. Potential follow up assessment with a healthcare professional, if needed.



response in the case of illness

- Updated health center policies, procedures and protocols with COVID-19 specific information
- Isolation and quarantine of campers and employees with COVID-19 like symptoms. Campers will be isolated, assessed, and if appropriate sent home
- Clear communication to all involved
- Will coordinate with local and state health departments



during camp

camper interaction

- First day Camper orientation providing information on COVID-19 safety precautions.
- Morning temperature check for all campers and staff before breakfast plus a daily "Are you feeling okay?" symptom check.
- Emphasis on handwashing with custom built handwashing stations available throughout camp.



face coverings

Camper masks will be optional.

- As of June 9, 2021 the Texas Department of State Health Services, who determines our operating procedures for camp, updated their policies regarding Covid19. Campers will no longer be required to wear a mask at any time.



camper mail

available on overnight opening day

- Camper emails are available through your T Bar M account. These emails will be printed and delivered to your camper the following day.
- The Camp Store will offer cabin deliveries. You can choose to pre-order camper store items through your T Bar M account.
- Overnight parents: if you would like to do camper mail, please prepare it before hand with the camper name on every package and we will have a mail drop off station as you drive through the opening day route.

camp property & facilities



- Routine cleaning and heightened disinfecting.



- Emphasis on head to foot bed layouts in camper cabins.



- Handwashing and hand sanitizer stations.



- Food Service operations to eliminate or reduce contact of frequently touched objects.



- Increased visitor restrictions.

intensified cleaning

- Deep cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing between camp sessions.
