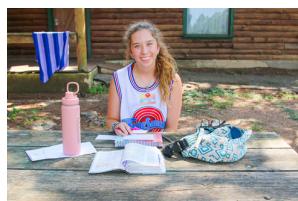

## ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
